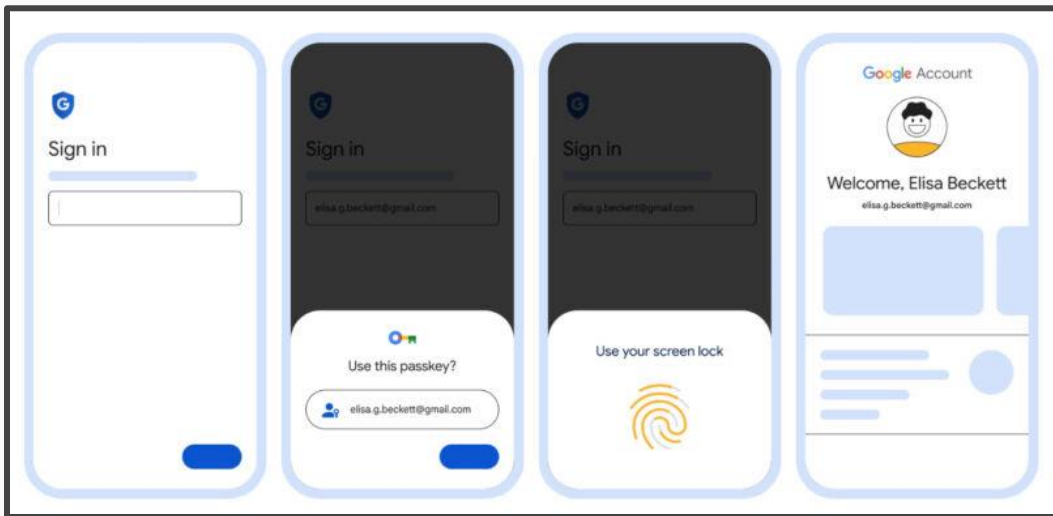

For the first time, we've begun rolling out passkeys, the easiest and most secure way to sign in to apps and websites and a major step toward a "passwordless future."

- Google announced rollout of "passkeys".
- Technology based on private/public key is supposed to replace passwords.
- Passkeys are not yet available for corporate accounts (Google Workspace)



Cybersecurity successes of law enforcement

- Genesis Market seizure was communicated on 5th of April
 - Coordinated action of law enforcement agencies around the World closed Genesis Market
 - List of compromised accounts uploaded to haveibeenpwned.com
 - BBC reported (12th of May) that Genesis Market is back online in the dark web
- 13 DDoS-as-a-service sites were taken down by FBI early May
- Breached Forums shut down late March
 - LeakBase gaining more attention in cybercriminal community
 - LeakBase does not allow to upload leaks from Russian companies/organizations to their web page
- Merck wins cyber insurance case - 1.4B USD

Notable data breaches in April/May

Social reception of a data breach is different than it was before

- Companies compromised in April/May: Dragos, Capita, Discord, ABB, T-Mobile, Uber, Western Digital, OpenAI...
- No direct correlation between companies stock price and disclosure of data breaches
- Companies are more eager to find post-mortem analysis of security incidents
